

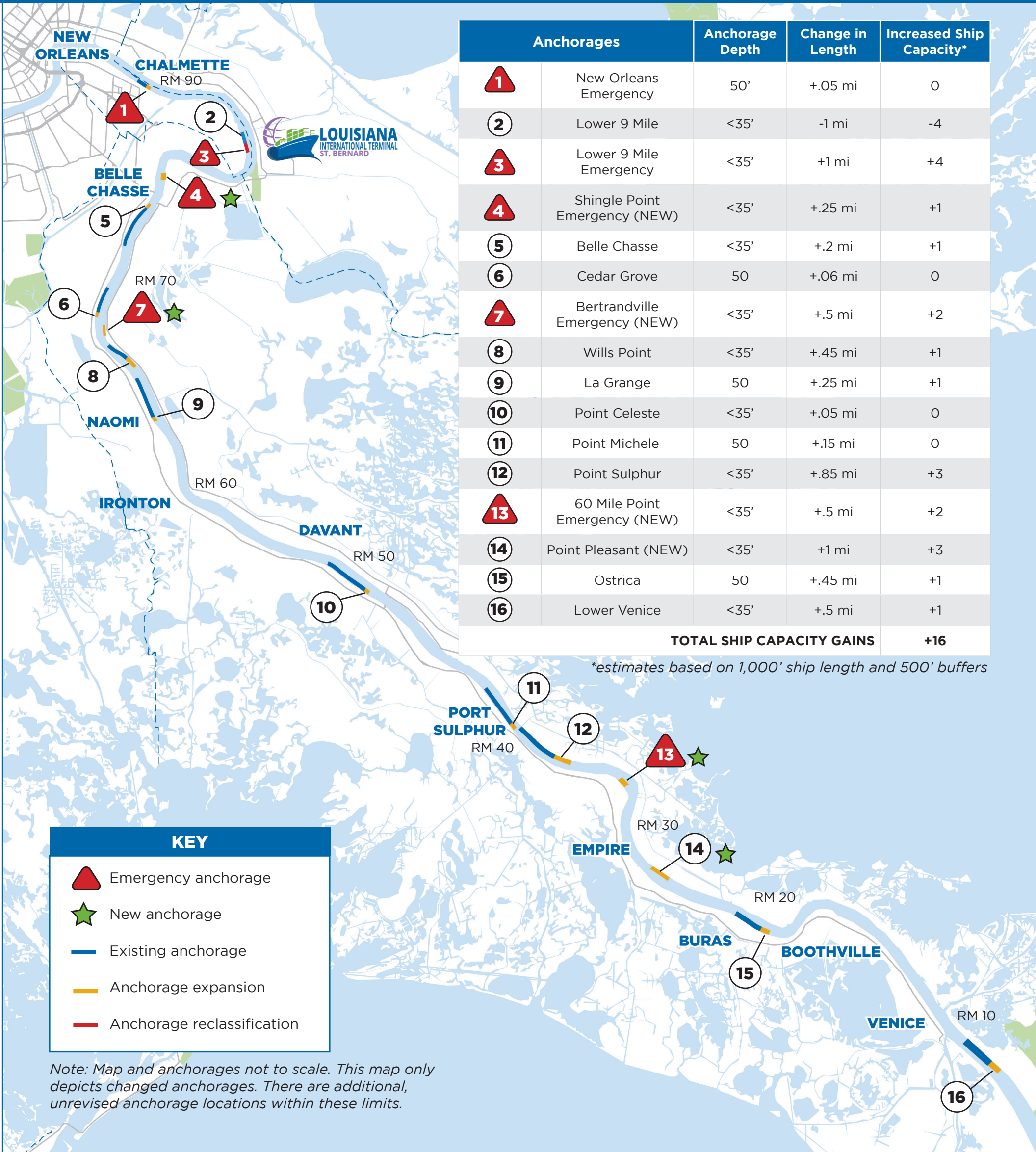
Lower Mississippi River Anchorage Improvements
